SSN1154	Aboriginal Studies 10	The course teaches students the perspectives and worldviews of Aboriginal peoples.

ESL1120	English as a Second Language - All Year - 5 Credit *Mandatory for ELL Students*	English as a Second Language instruction. Expanding students' knowledge of written and spoken English language.
SSN3171	Experimental Psychology 30	Students will gain an understanding of psychological research and experimentation and have an introduction to statistical analysis.
