Dear Parents/Guardians,

As you are aware on April 16 we informed all students and parents that École Camrose Composite High School will be shifting to remote learning, for all students in grades 9-12, for the next two weeks. Much like the transition to remote learning that we made in November, we would like to go back to those expectations that were implemented.

- All curricular outcomes and course instructional time will remain the same as "in school" learning. Attendance each day is very important so that students do not fall behind in coursework.
- Google classroom, Gmail, and "Google Meets" will be the main tools used to communicate with students. Students are expected to check their emails daily and connect with their teachers through google classroom. If they are having difficulty with this, please contact the school.
- Our current class schedule for each student will be followed with only slight adjustments.
- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each class through a Google Meet with their teacher (Please see Bell Schedule Below). Students are also expected to be available online throughout the class or as directed by their teacher.
- On April 20th at 1:00 p.m. ConnectED will reopen and students can log back into their accounts to verify their quarter 4 timetable (Quarter 4 begins April 21). Your teachers will also be sending out a google classroom invite for you to join your new classroom.
