Dear Parents/Guardians,

RE: Update Regarding School Athletics and Vaccinations

As you read in correspondence shared from the Division last week, at the request of Alberta Education and Alberta Health Services, BRSD has temporarily introduced "COVID-19 Hazard Control" measures. The intent is to help protect the health and safety of students and staff in schools while Alberta works to get through yet another wave of COVID 19.

Effective Friday, October 29th, all staff, parents/guardians, facility user groups, visiting sports teams, officials, spectators, and anyone else that wishes to enter the school will be required to provide either proof of vaccination or a negative rapid test result dated within 72 hours, prior to entering the school building or interacting with students. Although it is a priority to ensure school athletics remains strong and our extra-curricular activities continue to operate within a safe environment, we also understand the importance of including our parents/guardians in our school culture. We will do our best to make sure all of our home games continue to be live streamed so that you can cheer our teams on from the comfort of your homes and invite other friends and family members to do the same. This link will be located on our website and on our YouTube channel.

If you want to watch the games in person please note the following safety protocols:

- All parents/guardians (fans) that enter the building must present their vaccination record or a negative rapid test result dated within 72 hours prior. There will be a window of time (30 min prior to the start of each game and 15 min. after the start for both girls and boys teams) in which the front door of the school will be unlocked and a staff member will be checking these records. After the outlined time, admittance into the school will no longer be allowed and you will have to view the game via livestream.
- Masks must be worn by all visitors at all times. In addition, members from different households will be required to be seated 2m apart from each other. Members within the same household can sit next to each other.
- Immediately following your student's game we would ask that visitors exit the school in a timely manner.
- Due to the potential increase in numbers, we will be offering live streaming only for home tournaments, and no live spectators will be allowed in the school.

We hope that adherence to these safety protocols will allow us to continue to invite spectators to attend different live events in our school, so we thank you in advance for your cooperation around this and continued patience.
