Covid update from BRSD's Essential Readings

Why are schools continuing to operate? In the words of Alberta's Chief Medical Officer of Health, Alberta has "weighed many factors" when considering whether or not to have schools continue in-person learning. She says they are working hard to mitigate COVID risks, through all the measures schools have been taking, plus the addition of higher grade masks and rapid tests, and also minimize both the mental health risks and the learning gaps that develop when children are forced to be out of school. What are the criteria for switching a class or a grade to remote learning? Decisions will be based on: student absentee rates ability of a school to have staff available to operate in-person classes measures already taken any other relevant data

Question: How has BRSD's practice for ventilation and cleaning of school buildings changed during COVID?

Answer: Here's what we've been doing in Battle River: Extending the run times of ventilation systems, to allow a 'building flush' both before and after students and staff are in the buildings. That extra run time is now two full hours both before and after occupancy. Setting our ventilation systems for maximum fresh air intake. The 'maximum' varies, depending on outside air conditions - when it's very cold outside there is a freezing risk so the maximum intake is higher at some times than others. Installing the most efficient and high quality filters possible.

*We have upgraded the filters that we use in our ventilation systems and continue to evaluate if further upgrades can be made. Scheduling more frequent filter changes. BRSD has doubled the frequency of filter changes since the start of the pandemic.

*If a school experiences an outbreak or high case count, an additional filter change is done.

*BRSD schools are thoroughly cleaned on a daily basis but since the start of the pandemic: the type of cleaning materials has been modified, to include disinfecting agents, as well as cleaning agents. Supplies are available throughout school sites, if staff or students wish to provide additional wipe-downs of specific items during the day. In the event a school has an outbreak or high case numbers, an additional deep cleaning is done
