Number: several

Recipients must be attending a post-secondary institution (other than Augustana Campus of the University of Alberta) in the fall. Recipients must be good all-round students who have demonstrated good citizenship characteristics and service to their school and community. Financial need is a consideration.

Value: \$500

Number: 1

Criteria: Recipient must be a full-time student of ECCHS during the year of graduation and application. An average of 80% or higher in five 30-level courses required to enter the chosen area of study at university level. Extracurricular involvement in the community. Must be attending a post-secondary institution in the fall.

Number: 1

Criteria: achievement and community/school service. Enrolled in the initial year of full time study in Education at an accredited university or college.

Alice Thom Memorial Scholarship

Value: \$100

Number: 1

Criteria: Must be a grade 12 student at ECCHS. Recipient must be attending a post-secondary institution to pursue studies in fine art, art, drama or music in the fall term. Recipient will achieve honours standing at the 30 level in the area of focus - art, drama, or music and will achieve good overall academic standing.

Value: \$300

Number: 1

Criteria: for a rural resident of Camrose County who is hard-working, dedicated, shows initiative and makes a positive impact in their school and/or community.

Camrose Tour of Alberta (F.A.C.T.) Award for outstanding commitment to the Fitness and Cross-Training Program. This individual brings punctuality, excellent attendance and unwavering support of others.

Number: 1

Criteria: To be presented to the most deserving ECCHS grade 12 student, effective the year of their graduation. The recipient will be an all-round individual – active in athletics, drama, music, in or outside school, or other extracurricular activities. The recipient will achieve good academic standing however, honors standing is NOT a necessity. The recipient must NOT receive other ECCHS awards during the school year, with the exception of honors. The recipient is NOT required to continue his or her schooling to receive this award. Financial need will be a consideration of the award. Applicants please provide some details about how you intend to finance your education and whether there are extenuating circumstances the Awards Committee should be aware of.

Students must intend to pursue post-secondary study in music or drama (must have taken at least one music class) OR students must intend to pursue post-secondary study in teacher education or English literature.

Number: 1

Criteria: Awarded to the most deserving student of the senior stage band.

Value: \$2250/5

Number: 5

Criteria: Recipients must be attending a post-secondary institution in the fall. Demonstrated good leadership and citizenship skills in the school and community.

Errol Moen Memorial Award

Value: \$500

Number: 1

Criteria: Awarded to recipient for outstanding academic achievement and contribution to school and community.

Glen and Audrey Lett Scholarship

Value: TBD

Number: one

Criteria: Recipient is a graduating student who has participated in drama, choral music, or vocal music for credit or extracurricular and who is now attending Augustana in any field of study.

Hershita Sainbhee Memorial Scholarship

Value: \$1500

Number: 1

Criteria: Awarded to an honour student who contributes to life at ECCHS with acts of kindness, warmth and compassion and is pursuing post-secondary studies in any medical field.

Marty & Pam Proctor Award(s)

Value: \$5000 per year, possibly more

Number: 1+

Criteria: Consideration will be given to students who are not receiving other awards. Recipient(s) will have demonstrated strong work ethic to achieve grades to gain entrance into a post-secondary program (trade schools, colleges, or universities)

Melissa Austrom Endowment Fund

Value: \$300/3

Number: 3

Criteria: Recipient must be graduating this year. Student must have made an outstanding contribution to programs of the school and/or community. Student must intend to pursue post-secondary study in teacher education and must have acceptance from post-secondary institution. Student must not have received another major award at ECCHS. Financial need will be a consideration.

Norman and Eloise Umbach Scholarship

Value: \$200

Number: 1

Criteria: Graduating student from ECCHS pursuing a career in teacher or nursing. Preference given to an average student who has demonstrated service and leadership qualities.

Open Circle CTS Award

Value: \$300

Number: 1

Criteria: student who is interested in CTS Trades courses and who demonstrated leadership and cooperative approach in the CTS classroom.

Reynolds Academic Scholarship

Value: \$500/2

Number: 1-2

Criteria: Recipient must be a full-time student at ECCHS during the year of graduation and application. Must have honours standing. Extracurricular involvement in school and community. Must be attending a post-secondary institution in the fall.

Reynolds Vocational Scholarship

Value: \$500

Number: 1

Criteria: Student must be graduating, demonstrates a positive attitude and a strong work ethic. Not necessarily strong academically; not necessarily honour student. Student must be pursuing a career in the trades, technical school or apprenticeship. Selection based on recommendation of the CTS department.

Rhine Family Award for Cosmetology

Value: \$200

Number: 1

Criteria: Recipient must be a student who has demonstrated the greatest improvement in Cosmetology based on effort and conduct. Recipient does not necessarily have to have the highest mark.

Value: \$200/2

Number: 2

Criteria: Full time ECCHS student accepted in post -secondary program with honors and good citizenship with school and community

Value: \$300

Number: 1

Criteria: Awarded to a student entering into a culinary arts program

Sharon Saunders Memorial Award

Value: \$100

Number: 1

Criteria: Awarded to the student who in the opinion of the teaching staff has exhibited outstanding personal qualities.

Stan and Gladys Hambly Scholarship

Value: \$400/3

Number: 3

Criteria: Recipient must intend to pursue a career in teaching and must be a good all-around student.

Steven Phillips Sportsmanship Memorial Award

Value: TBD

Number: 1

Criteria: Recipient displays consistent high level of sportsmanship and leadership in a number of school & community sports and is pursuing post secondary.

Government of Alberta Scholarship, Awards, & Bursary Program

Alexander Rutherford

Value: Up to \$2500 each

Number: Available to all Alberta students.

Criteria: Based on academic achievement in Grades 10 and/or 11 and/or 12 for post-secondary study at colleges, technical schools or universities. Overall average of 80% or higher in 5 subjects,

including English. The selected subjects are most flexible in grade 10 and least in grade 12.

Apply in Grade 12 year for all three grades.

Deadline: May 1, December 1
