<b>MAXIMUM SUM INSURED</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• \$1,000,000 per insured person</li></ul>
<b>COVERAGE TYPE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Multi-trip; up to 30 days per trip</li></ul>
<b>ELIGIBLE MEDICAL EXPENSES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Emergency treatment for sickness or injury, whether in-patient or out-patient</li><li>• Services of physician, surgeon, anesthetist, registered graduate nurse, nursing aid</li><li>• X-rays, laboratory and diagnostic services</li><li>• Crutches, casts, splints, canes, slings, trusses, braces, walkers; rental of a wheelchair, iron lung, or hospital type bed</li></ul>
<b>EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Licensed ground ambulance</li><li>• Air ambulance</li><li>• Medical repatriation up to \$10,000</li></ul>
<b>PRESCRIPTION DRUGS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Prescription medications required for emergency medical treatment</li></ul>
<b>PARAMEDICAL SERVICES AND PRIVATE DUTY NURSING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Services of physiotherapist, chiropractor, chiropodist, podiatrist, or osteopath</li><li>• Services of a registered private duty nurse</li></ul>
<b>TRANSPORTATION TO BEDSIDE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Up to \$5,000 for round trip economy airfare for one chaperone, medical attendant, or family member, and up to \$3,000 for costs incurred after arrival</li></ul>
<b>SPECIFIC LOSS INDEMNITY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Accidental Death &amp; Dismemberment: Up to \$25,000 per covered loss, to an aggregate limit of \$50,000</li><li>• Paralysis: Up to \$50,000 per accident</li><li>• Prosthetic appliances due to accident: \$2,000</li></ul>
<b>TRIP CANCELLATION / INTERRUPTION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Trip cancellation up to \$5,000</li><li>• Trip interruption up to \$25,000</li><li>• Incidental expenses due to trip cancellation/interruption up to \$350 per day to \$1,500 maximum</li><li>• Up to \$2,500 for one-way economy airfare for an insured person to rejoin the trip</li></ul>
<b>LOST OR DAMAGED BAGGAGE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• \$375 per item, to a maximum of \$1,500</li><li>• Up to \$100 for stolen personal currency</li><li>• Up to \$200 for necessary toiletries if checked baggage is delayed over 12 hours</li><li>• Up to \$100 for repairs or rental replacement of a damaged wheelchair</li></ul>
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students and chaperones at participating schools, under the age of 70</li></ul>
